**THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY BAPTISM**

*The baptismal group gathers around the baptismal font.*

**INVOCATION**

Pastor: In the name of the Father and of the † Son and of the Holy Spirit.

**People: Amen.**

P: Our Lord commanded Baptism, saying to His disciples in the last chapter of Matthew: “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son † and of the Holy Spirit and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I will be with you always, to the very end of the age.” The holy apostles of the Lord have written: “The promise is for you and your children,” and “Baptism now saves you.”

P: We also learn from the Word of God that we are all conceived and born sinful and are under the power of the devil until Christ claims us as His own. We would be lost forever unless delivered from sin, death, and everlasting condemnation. But the Father of all mercy and grace has sent His Son Jesus Christ, who atoned for the sin of the whole world, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. Receive the sign of the holy cross both upon your forehead † and upon your heart † to mark you as one redeemed by Christ the crucified. Hear how our Lord Jesus Christ has opened the kingdom of God to little children. People were bringing little children to Jesus to have Him touch them, but the disciples rebuked them. When Jesus saw this, He was indignant. He said to them, “Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. I tell you the truth, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it.”

P: This is the gospel of the Lord.

**All: Praise to You, O Christ.**

P: It is your task as parents and sponsors to confess with the whole Church the faith in our God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, into whose name **ISAIAH JAMES LANNING** is to be baptized. After **ISAIAH** is Baptized, you are at all times to remember him in your prayers, put **ISAIAH** in mind of his Baptism, and, as much as in you lies, give your counsel and aid, especially if **ISAIAH** should lose his parents, that **ISAIAH** be brought up in the true knowledge and worship of God and be taught the Ten Commandments,

the Creed, and the Lord's Prayer; and that, as he grows in years, you place in his hands the Holy Scriptures, bring **ISAIAH** to the services of God's house, and provide for his further instruction in the Christian faith, that **ISAIAH** comes to the Sacrament of Christ's Body and Blood and thus, abiding in his baptismal grace and in communion with the Church, **ISAIAH** may grow up to lead a godly life to the praise and honor of Jesus Christ. This, then, you intend gladly and willingly to do?

**All: Yes.**

P: God enable you both to will and to do this faithful and loving work and with His grace fulfill what we are unable to do. In order to implore the blessing of our Lord Jesus Christ upon the gathering of **ISAIAH** into the family of our Father, let us with the families pray the prayer He gave us.

**All: Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.**

P: The Lord preserve your coming in and your going out from this time forth and even forevermore.

**All: Amen.**

P: Because **ISAIAH** cannot answer for himself, we shall all, together with sponsors and parents, faithfully speak on his behalf in testimony of the forgiveness of sin and the birth of the life of faith which God our Father bestows in and through Baptism.

P: Do you, **ISAIAH**, renounce the devil and all his works and all his ways?

**All: I do renounce them.**

P: Do you believe in God, the Father Almighty?

**All: Yes, I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.**

P: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son?

**All: Yes, I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.**

P: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit?

**All: Yes, I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.**

P: Who brings this child of God to be baptized?

**R: We do.**

P: How is this child (or person) to be named?

**R: ISAIAH JAMES LANNING .**

P: **ISAIAH JAMES LANNING**, I baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son † and of the Holy Spirit. Almighty God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has given you the new birth of water and the Spirit and has forgiven you all your sins, strengthen you with His grace to life everlasting. Peace be

with you.

**All: Amen.**

P: Receive this burning light. Live always by the light of Christ, and be ever watchful for His coming that you may meet Him with joy and enter with Him to the marriage feast of the Lamb in the kingdom, which shall have no end. *The baptismal group gathers before the altar.*

P: Let us pray.

Almighty and most merciful God and Father, we thank and praise You that You graciously preserve and enlarge Your family and have granted **ISAIAH** the new birth in Holy Baptism and made him a member of Your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, and heir of Your heavenly kingdom. We humbly beseech You that, as **ISAIAH** has now become Your child, You would keep him in his baptismal grace that according to all Your good pleasure he may faithfully grow to lead a godly life to the praise and honor of Your holy name and finally with all Your saints obtain the promised inheritance in heaven; through Jesus Christ, our Lord.

**All: Amen.**

P: Lord and giver of life, look with kindness upon the parents of **ISAIAH** and upon all our parents. Let them ever rejoice in the gift You have given them. Enable them to be teachers and examples of righteousness for their children. Strengthen them in their own Baptism so that they may share eternally with their children the Salvation You have given them; through Jesus Christ, our Lord.

**All: Amen.**

P: Through Baptism, God has added **ISAIAH** to His own people to declare the wonderful deeds of our Savior, who has called us out of darkness into His marvelous light.

**All: We welcome you into the Lord's family. We receive you as a fellow member of the body of Christ, children of the same heavenly Father, to work with us in His kingdom.**

P: And you, **ISAIAH**, the Lord bless you in all your ways from this time forth and forevermore.

**All: Amen.**

**3** Now there was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. <sup>2</sup>This man came to Jesus by night and said to him, “Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher come from God, for no one can do these signs that you do unless God is with him.” <sup>3</sup>Jesus answered him, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God.” <sup>4</sup>Nicodemus said to him, “How can a man be born when he is old? ## COMMISSIONING OF YOUTH GATHERING ATTENDEES
